Subject:- Grant of Conditional Permission to DGM, JSVV Samsthe's Danappa Gurushiddapa Melmalagi Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & PG Research Centre Gadag, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0080) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 04 PG course with 19 seats in the subjects namely (i) Kaya Chikitsa -05 seats ii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 04 seats (iii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats (iv) Panchakarma- 05 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM Act, 2020 shall not be applicable.

- Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **DGM, JSVV Samsthe's Danappa Gurushiddapa Melmalagi Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & PG Research Centre Gadag, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0080)** inspection of your College was conducted on **04.03.2024 & 05.03.2024 in hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 19 Seats in each 04 PG course in the subjects namely i) Kaya Chikitsa -05 seats ii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 04 seats (iii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats (iv) Panchakarma- 05 seats for the academic session 2024-25.**
- Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations thereunder.
- Thereafter, the assessment report was placed in the **96th Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on **05.07.2024**. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that **your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcomings :-**

I. Teaching staffs:-

a) Availability of total teaching staff for UG is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{27}{30} \times 100\% = 90.00\%$ (Excluding Excess and considering visitor observation report)

4. However, as per regulation 3(3) (a) of MSR, 2016, the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for conditional permission for the academic year 2024-25. Hence the Board decided to issue the Conditional Permission with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 19 Seats in each 04 PG course in the subjects namely i) Kaya Chikitsa -05 seats ii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 04 seats (iii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats (iv) Panchakarma- 05 for the academic session 2024-25.
5. Further, the Board is in receipt of a letter no. DGM/AMC/2024 dated 20.07.2024 regarding request for consideration of allotment of 05 PG seats in Panchakarma department. Thereafter, again the assessment report was placed in the 103rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 21.08.2024 and 22.08.2024. On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is fulfilling the notified & approved criteria.
6. Therefore, Conditional Permission is granted to DGM, JSVV Samsthe's Danappa Gurushiddapa Melmalagi Ayurvedic Medical College, Hospital & PG Research Centre Gadag, Karnataka (Inst. ID AYU0080) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 19 Seats in each 04 PG course in the subjects namely i) Kaya Chikitsa -05 seats ii) Dravyaguna Vigyana- 04 seats (iii) Rasa Shastra & Bhaisajya Kalpana-05 seats (iv) Panchakarma- 05 seats for the academic session 2024-25 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 subject to the condition that college is fulfilling the following conditions as mentioned below: -
- The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the colleges/hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant rules and regulations.
 - It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of **60 seats in UG** and that minimum 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted **19 Seats in 04 PG courses** shall be treated as All India Quota. The counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counselling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25 and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counselling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
 - It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the guidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to the MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-2026:**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2022;
 - iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
 - v) The shortcoming mentioned in **Para no. 3** above, should be fulfilled.
10. The fulfilment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
11. The letter of even number dated 15.07.2024 hereby stands withdrawn.
